- 一、為鼓勵優秀高中畢業生就讀本校,特訂定「國立成功大學獎勵優秀高中生就讀本 校獎學金要點」(以下簡稱本要點)。
- The NCKU Directions for Scholarship for Admission of Outstanding High School
  Graduates (hereinafter the Directions) are established by National Cheng Kung University
  (NCKU) to promote the admission of outstanding high school graduates into its
  undergraduate programs.

## 二、獎學金種類與名額:

(一)大學考試分發入學成績優異者:

凡以第一志願錄取本校各學系且指定科目考試成績,一科成績為該科成績前百分之一以內,另一科成績為該科成績前百分之二以內,其餘科目成績之平均為前百分之三以內,並經各學系審查通過者,每班最多錄取五名為原則。經審查後如有成績優異,惟未達上述標準者,得簽請校長斟酌給予全部或部分獎學金之獎勵。

- (二)依教育部「參加國際數理學科奧林匹亞競賽及國際科學展覽成績優良學生 升學優待辦法」審查取得保送資格,經錄取進入本校就讀者。
- (三)其他非考試分發入學管道(含甄選入學、繁星計畫及運動績優學生等)錄取者,經各學系審查通過,每系最多錄取一名為原則。

## (四)學科能力測驗成績達滿級分者。

- 2. Scholarship Categories and Quotas:
  - (1) Those admitted with outstanding test scores in the joint college entrance examination: Those admitted into NCKU as their top preference university with the test score of one designated subject ranked among the first one percent of all applicants, another one among the first two percent and a third one among the first three percent are eligible applicants for the scholarship. Each department shall review its applicants and approve a maximum of five recipients from each class according to the criteria. Should the department intend to recommend a student with outstanding test scores failing to meet the criteria as a scholarship recipient, a special report shall be submitted and approved by the President.
  - (2) Those admitted with admission qualifications according to the MOE Regulations Governing Academic Advancement Incentives for Students Who Compete and Perform Well in International Mathematics or Science Olympiads and International Science Fairs.
  - (3) Those admitted through non-examination-oriented admission channels (including the screening admission system for recommended students, Stars Program for students from remote areas, and the admission system for outstanding athletes). Every department shall review these students and approve a maximum of one scholarship recipient.
  - (4) Those admitted with the top combined score of 75 points on General Scholastic Ability Test (the top score of 15 points for each of the five designated testing subjects).
- 三、前述獎學金於入學後每學期發給新台幣伍萬元整,至多發入學期。
- 3. A scholarship recipient as defined in the preceding rule will receive NT\$50,000 every semester for a maximum of eight semesters.
- 四、未辦理保留入學資格或休學、轉系者,其前一學期學業成績達80分以上或排名在全班前25%或在所屬班級得獎人數1.5倍名次以內者,該學期可續領本獎學金。
- 4. A scholarship recipient enrolled in the current semester as a continuing student in the same department with an academic grade of 80 or above, or ranked academically within the first 25% of students in class, or within the top list of 1.5 times the number of scholarship recipients for the preceding semester, shall continue to receive the granted scholarship.
- 五、另為鼓勵其他優秀高中畢業學生就讀本校各學系,凡大學考試分發入學錄取本校 各學系,其原始成績超過錄取之系最低錄取原始分數百分之十三以上,限於未經 因特種考生身分加重計分之原始總分。名額不限,入學後每名發給新台幣伍萬元 整,轉系則應退還獎學金。
- 5. Meanwhile, as another incentive to promote admission of outstanding high school graduates, each of those admitted into any NCKU undergraduate program through the

joint college entrance examination with their original test score 13% higher than the original lowest score designated by the program shall receive a scholarship of NT\$50,000 upon enrollment. These recipients shall return the scholarship should they later transfer into a different program.

- 六、獎學金由相關文教基金會及熱心教育之財團法人和社會人士提供,或由本校編列 經費。
- 6. The scholarship is funded by donations from various NCKU-related cultural and educational foundations, education-minded incorporation legal entities, members of the society, or by the NCKU-designated school budget.
  - 七、本獎學金之審核由各學系辦理初審作業,複審作業由獎學金審核委員會審核,業 務由教務處辦理。
- 7. Each department shall conduct a preliminary review of scholarship grants, which shall be approved by the NCKU Scholarship Review Committee. Affairs related to the scholarship review shall be administered by the Office of Academic Affairs.
- 八、各院系亦得自籌經費另訂定獎學金給予辦法。
- 8. Each college or department may raise a scholarship fund on their own with a set of regulations.
- 九、本要點所列各項獎學金種類不得重覆頒發。
- 9. Each recipient shall be granted a scholarship from only one category.
- 十、本要點經主管會報通過後實施,修正時亦同。
- 10 These Directions shall be approved by a regular meeting of the Chief Administrators before taking effect. Any amendments shall be processed accordingly.
